### JOE BIDEN: A FRIEND OF THE MIDDLE CLASS

Before he left the Senate and became vice president, Biden had a **100% voting record on working family issues** and a lifetime voting rating - over 35 years - of 85 percent.<sup>1</sup>

Joe Biden appointed **President Stephenson** to his **Climate Engagement Advisory Council**, demonstrating his commitment to ensuring the **IBEW** has a seat at this table.

### REBUILDING AMERICA'S INFRASTRUCTURE

Joe Biden will harness the skills of American workers to:<sup>2</sup>

- **Rebuild** electricity grids, water systems, bridges, roads, and rail lines
- **Promote domestic energy security** by promoting nuclear, battery storage, and carbon capture
- **Create 1 million new jobs** in domestic auto infrastructure, including parts, materials and electric vehicle charging stations

### JOE BIDEN SUPPORTS:<sup>3</sup>

- The **PRO Act**, which will protect workers' right to organize and bargain collectively
- Extending **the right to organize** to independent contractors
- **Project labor agreements**
- **Prevailing wages on all infrastructure** and transportation projects
- Creating a **cabinet-level working group** that will focus on promoting unions
- **Banning "right-to-work"**
- Reinstating weakened occupational and safety standards
- Federally registered apprenticeships
- **Passage of the Butch Lewis Act** to help troubled multiemployer pension plans

## OSHA: NOT PROTECTING SAFETY AND HEALTH

- The Trump Department of Labor **refuses to issue an emergency standard to protect workers** during the pandemic
  - OSHA has only released voluntary "guidance"
- The number of OSHA inspections has fallen drastically under Trump<sup>7</sup>

## TRUMP: WILL VETO PRO ACT

Trump statement after House of Representatives passed the PRO Act, which will protect workers' right to organize and bargain collectively:

*"If H.R. 2474 were presented to the President in its current form, his advisors would recommend that he veto it."<sup>9</sup> (2/5/20)*

## TRUMP: ENDORSED BY ABC

President Trump is touting his reelection endorsement by the Associated Builders and Contractors, who said:

*"Your promise to veto the PRO Act ... assures us that you will protect the merit shop industry..."<sup>10</sup>*

## WATERED DOWN, LOW-QUALITY APPRENTICESHIPS?

Trump called for the DOL to establish a new apprenticeship system

- Known as the **Industry-Recognized Apprenticeship Program (IRAP)**, it would allow employers to create their own watered-down apprenticeship standards<sup>11</sup>
- Would make it easier for low-road contractors to replace union members with **lesser-skilled, low-wage workers**
- On 3/10/20, the Trump Administration backed off its plan to undermine the century-old construction apprenticeship system<sup>12</sup> in the face of opposition

## DONALD TRUMP'S SECOND TERM: GOODBYE, DAVIS-BACON

- White House details plans **to effectively repeal Davis-Bacon**, without congressional approval<sup>13</sup>
- Davis-Bacon enforcement is already lagging
  - Davis-Bacon enforcement investigations have gone down by 20 percent<sup>14</sup>
  - If the Department of Labor will not enforce Davis-Bacon, low road contractors will drag down wages
